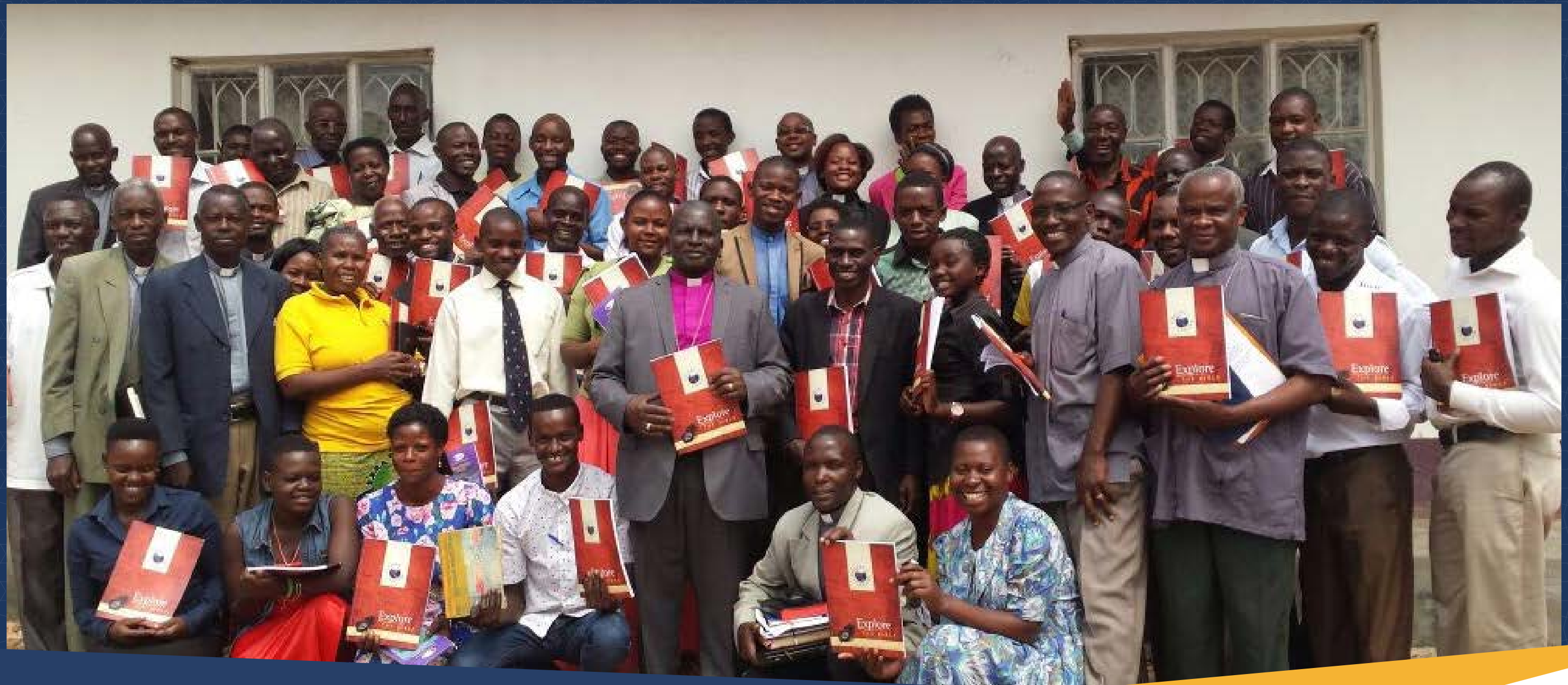

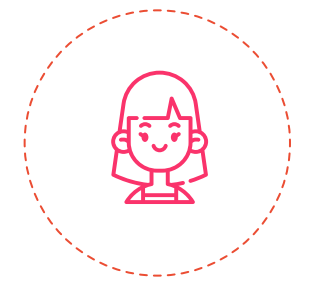

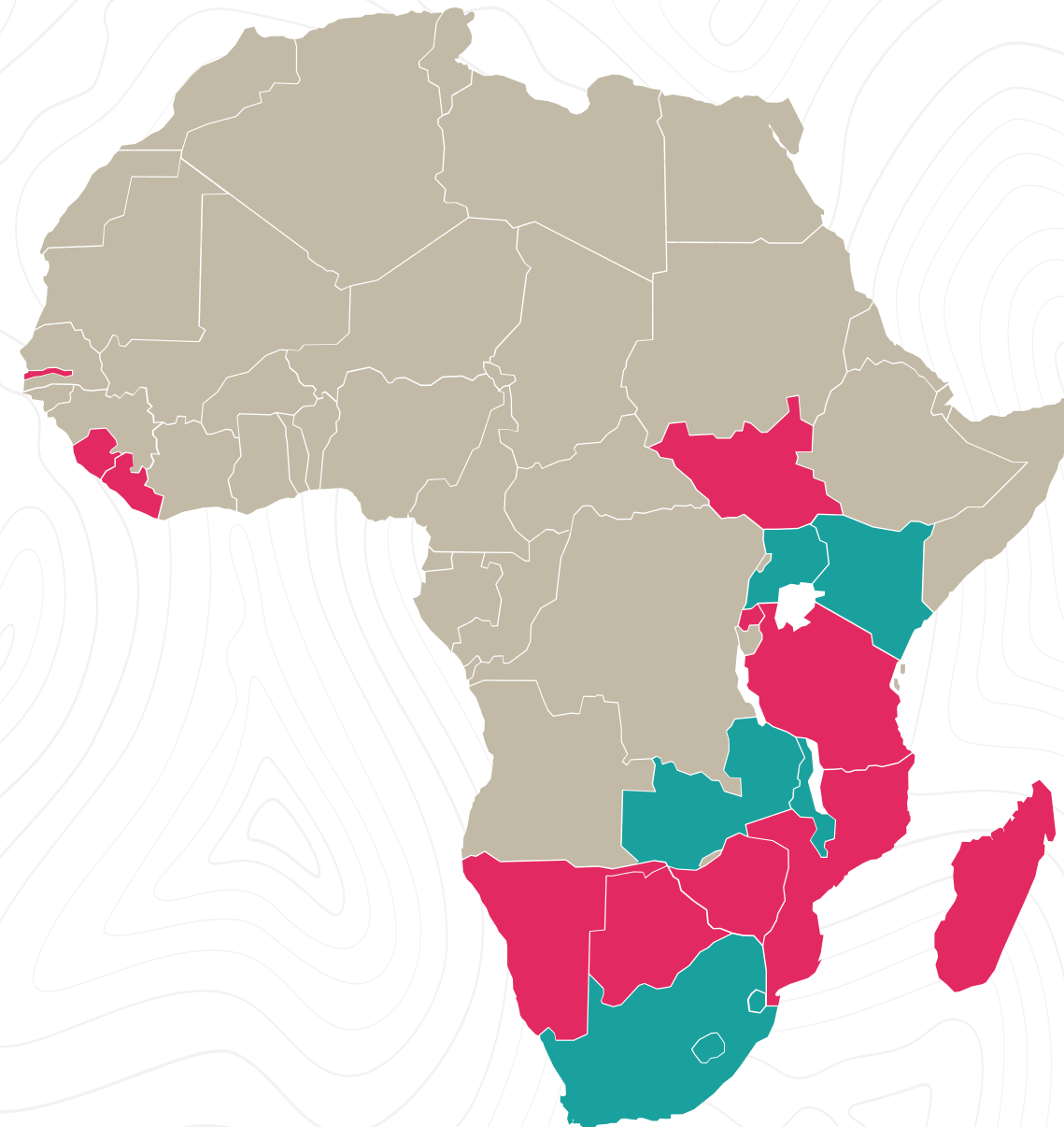
GWC Postgrad

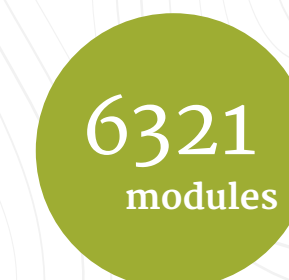

Students enrolled in 2024



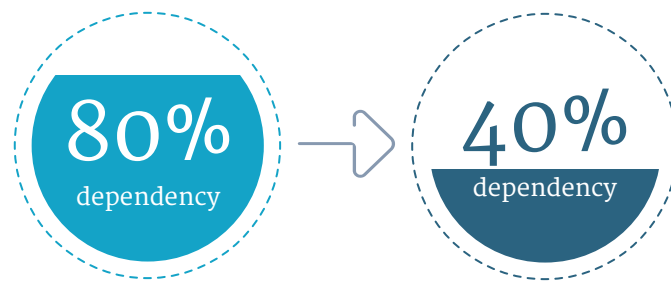
Modules studied in 2024





GWC Ark Endowment Fund

The Investment Objective



To reduce GWC's current dependency on annual donations from 80% to 40%

The Financial Return Goal



To grow an Endowment that will eventually yield 50% or more of the College annual core operational costs



In the first five years the goal is to raise USD 15 000 000, AUD 19 000 000, GBP 11 000 000 by 2026

Investment Strategy & Distribution Policy

- **Maximize total long-term investment return** to protect the value of each endowment fund against inflation or undue market risk
- **Preservation mandate** – This is a permanent endowment that will distribute up to 5% of the balance per year leaving the principal intact for the long term



Investment Fund



- The Fund will initially be a donor advised fund (DAF) housed by **TrustBridge Global** (TBG)
- The Fund shall be the **exclusive property of TrustBridge Global**, held by it in its corporate capacity
- The 5 year goal is to create a separate Trust to host the GWC Ark Endowment Fund

Why TrustBridge Global?

- TBG are a **Christian Foundation**
- TBG work with established Global collaborative partnerships offering convenient contributions to the endowment directly to TrustBridge in Switzerland, or through many of its global network members **offering tax deductible options**
- TBG provide stability, safety, neutrality of housing the Fund in a Swiss account
- TBG offer **extensive investment experience** & broad availability of investments

- GWC's stewardship & governance practise is **based on biblical principles** and is **annually assessed by the Africa Council for Accreditation and Accountability (AfCAA)**.
