Dinosaur Soft Tissue and the Age of the Earth

In 2012, Dr Mark Armitage dug up a triceratops brow horn in Montana. Upon analysing it in his lab, he was shocked to discover noncalcified soft tissue (collagen, cells, clots, and nerves), structures that would not have survived over millions of years and which are instead consistent with evidence of drowning.

In his talk, Dr Armitage will present findings that he believes are consistent with a catastrophic global flood and discuss their implications for biblical creation and the historicity of Noah's Flood.
